A slightly acidic environment can make Orbeez grow faster, which can be achieved with common kitchen ingredients such as lemon juice or vinegar. It's recommended to use a pH testing strip to ensure accuracy. In our experiments, we discovered that warm water at 110 degrees F was the most effective method, allowing the Orbeez to reach their full size in under two hours. Well, first things first, if your water's pH value goes above 7, just add some vinegar and lemon juice to make it more acidic. - I personally like the latter for its smell. But be warned, using vinegar might make them a bit stinky. I tried soaking my Orbeez in distilled or demineralized water, which made them grow faster and bigger, but they got super sticky afterwards, so I had to wash them before use. The size of your gel blaster balls also depends on the minerals in your tap water - if it's too hard (above 300 PPM), it can slow down the hydration process. Another trick is to start with larger Orbeez in the first place - they come in all sorts of sizes, not just the standard ones. And if you really want to supersize your game, try getting some "large" or "XL" sized ones - trust me, it's worth it! But did you know that sugar can also help make them bigger? Just add some to the water before dropping in your gel balls and mix well - just be aware that they might get a bit sticky. And if you're feeling adventurous, try using sparkling water - it might make them grow faster or bigger, but be careful not to overdo it, or they might become unstable. Oh, and one more thing: proper storage is key to keeping your Orbeez fresh and happy! While Orbeez are absorbing water, heat can speed up their expansion but UV rays from direct sunlight can cause harm, leading to deformities and color loss. To preserve them, store in a cool, dark place. Adding Borax can make them grow bigger, but it's not recommended due to skin and eye irritation risks. Oil doesn't help with growth, but makes the balls firmer. Alcohol dissolves polymers and breaks down beads. Using warm water or adding sugar promotes growth. If Orbeez aren't growing fast enough, try using warm water, distilling and increasing pH value, and adding salt or sugar. Salt stops expansion due to sodium ions blocking water absorption.
